Why Char Dham Yatra?

The **Char Dham Yatra** is one of the most sacred journeys in Hinduism, undertaken for spiritual purification and inner peace. It includes visits to four holy shrines—**Yamunotri, Gangotri, Kedarnath, and Badrinath**—located in the Himalayas.

This yatra is believed to cleanse a person of sins (paap) and help attain moksha (liberation). Each site represents a different divine aspect: Yamunotri and Gangotri are linked to sacred rivers, Kedarnath is dedicated to Lord Shiva, and Badrinath to Lord Vishnu. The journey also symbolizes devotion, self-discipline, and connection with nature and the divine.

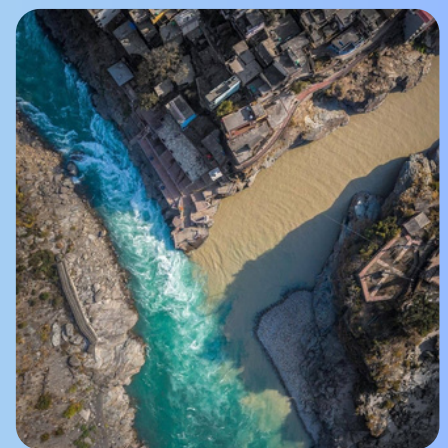
In essence, the Char Dham Yatra is performed to seek blessings, spiritual growth, and liberation from the cycle of life and death.

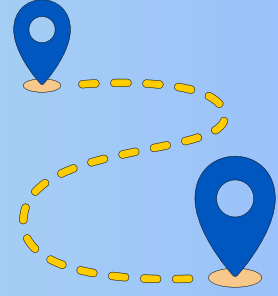

Day-wise Itinerary

Day 1: Delhi – Haridwar (222 Kms: 6-7 hrs. drive)

Pick-up from Akshardham Metro Station Gate No. 1 (timing will be updated after itinerary confirmation), then drive to Haridwar. In the evening, attend Ganga Aarti at Har Ki Pauri.

Day 2 : Haridwar – Barkot (205 Kms: 7-8 hrs.)

Morning, drive to Barkot, located on the foothills of Yamunotri, enroute stop-over at the Kempty Falls of Mussoorie. On arrival, check-in to your hotel.

Day 3: Barkot – Yamunotri – Barkot
(45 km drive / 2 hrs + 5 km trek each way)

Depart at 5:00 AM for Janki Chatti, where you will begin the first trek to Yamunotri (5 km). On arrival, take a holy dip in the hot Jamunabai Kund, followed by temple darshan. Return via the same route to Barkot, You can hire a Doli or a horse, for your trek (payable directly).

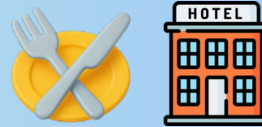
Day 4: Barkot – Uttarkashi (95 Kms: 4-5 hrs. drive)

Check out and drive to Uttarkashi. En route, visit Praketeshwar Mahadev Temple. In the evening, visit Vishwanath Temple.

Uttarkashi is situated on the banks of river Bhagirathi and is famous for its historical monuments, Temples & Ashrams.

Day 5: Uttarkashi – Gangotri – Uttarkashi (97 km / 3-4 hrs each way)

Early morning pickup for Gangotri. Upon arrival, take a holy dip in the River Ganges and visit the Gangotri Temple. After performing pooja, drive back to Uttarkashi

Day 6: Uttarkashi – Guptkashi (203 Kms: 8-9 hrs. drive)

Check out from the hotel and drive to Guptkashi enroute visit Tehri Dam and the Mandakini River at Tilwara. In the evening, check in at the hotel, then visit Ardhnareshwar Temple.

**Day 7: Guptkashi – Gaurikund – Kedarnath
(30 Kms Drive + 16 Kms upwards Trek)**

Early morning at 4:00 AM, check out from the hotel and drive to Gaurikund. En route, visit Sonprayag to witness the confluence of the Ganga and Mandakini rivers. From here, begin your 16 km trek to Kedarnath and arrive by evening.

Check in at the camps and proceed for temple darshan. Also visit the Adi Shankaracharya Samadhi located behind the temple.

You can hire a Doli or a horse, for your trek (payable directly).

**Day 8: Kedarnath – Guptkashi
(14 Kms Downwards Trek + 30 Kms Drive)**

Early morning, visit the temple at 4:45 AM for Abhishek at Kedarnath. After darshan and puja, return to the camp. Later, begin the 16 km return trek from Kedarnath to Gaurikund. Vehicles will be waiting at Gaurikund to drive you back to the hotel.

Rudra Abhishek at Kedarnath is optional and payable directly at the temple.

**Day 9: Guptkashi – Joshimath – Badrinath
(200 Kms: 7-8 hrs. Drive)**

Check out of the hotel and drive to Badrinath via Joshimath

Upon arrival, check in at the Hotel. After some rest and refreshments, proceed for Badrinath Temple darshan. First, visit Tapt Kund (hot spring) for a holy bath, and then go to the temple. Later, return to the hotel.

Day 10: Badrinath – Joshimath – Rudraprayag
(195 Kms: 6-7 hrs. drive)

This morning, proceed to Badrinath. After darshan, return to the hotel, check out, and proceed for Badrinath local sightseeing. Visit Mana Village, the last village before the Tibetan border, Bheem Pul, Vyas Gufa, and the Saraswati River.

In the afternoon, drive back to Rudraprayag via Karanprayag. En route, visit Narsingh Temple and Adi Shankaracharya Samadhi at Joshimath. Rudraprayag is a small pilgrim town located at the holy confluence of the Alaknanda and Mandakini rivers.

On arrival, check in at the hotel. The rest of the day is free to explore Rudraprayag town.

Day 11 : Rudraprayag – Rishikesh.– Haridwar
(230 Kms: 7-8 hrs. drive)

Early morning Drive downhill to Rishikesh, On arrival, visit Ram Jhula and Laxman Jhula, then continue to Haridwar.

Drive back to Delhi. On arrival at Delhi, transfer to airport/railway station to catch the flight/train for onward destination.

Tips to Travel

- Here are some traveling tips for Char Dham Yatra listed below which one should keep in mind before travelling.
- While visiting Hindu mythological sites, shrines and temples, one should remove shoes and cover head with a piece of cloth before entering the Holy Place, so remember to carry one while packing your bags.
- Women should try and avoid wearing sarees during Trekking, and instead wear salwar, pants or trousers.
- Ponies, and palkis, are available for yatris, so if you are feeling weak or tired, you should take their help to complete the yatra.
- Do not take pictures if cameras are not allowed in temples
- Communication: Although all private mobile phones have coverage, Airtel & Jio network is better in most of the places.
- During boarding and travel all passengers shall use face cover/mask. They will also follow hand hygiene, respiratory hygiene and environmental hygiene.
- The approximate charge for one way Doli to Yamunotri shall be Rs.6500 per person & Kedarnath is R.12,000 per person. However it can subject to change due to demand in the area.
- This is a Pilgrimage sector so don't keep high expectations in Hotels except Haridwar.
- Kedarnath Yatra is not advisable for Asthama & Heart Patients – Consult your Doctor before joining
- Fitness: All pilgrims should be physically fit. It is better to do some jogging and other light exercise as you prepare for this journey.
